EACH YEAR AT THEIR ANNUAL CONFERENCE the Friends of Dard Hunter raises funds for scholarships through cash donations and the silent auctions. These funds are then applied to the scholarships the following year. If you would not otherwise be able to afford this year's joint meeting, perhaps a scholarship would help to make it possible. You must be a current graduate student and member of either FDH or APHA at the time you apply for a scholarship. (If you are not currently a member, student memberships are available at both [FDH](#) and [APHA](#).) Please note that you are ineligible for consideration if you have received a FDH or APHA scholarship within the last three years. You may

apply again after the three-year waiting period. Depending upon availability of funds, scholarships will waive your conference fee and offer a complimentary ticket to the banquet at the close of the conference in exchange for volunteering four hours of time during the conference and writing a brief article (100-500 words) on any event you attend. They do not cover the travel or lodging expenses. If, in any given year, the number of applicants exceeds the amount of funds available, selections will be made by the Executive Committee. All applicants will be notified in a timely manner after the deadline to allow for the completion of travel plans.

To apply for this scholarship, please submit a letter that includes the following:

1. Name, street address, email, and phone.
2. What do you expect to get out of this conference?
3. How do you anticipate this experience will benefit you?
4. As a scholarship recipient, are you willing to volunteer to assist with conference activities as needed?
5. Do you have specific skills that you would like to volunteer?
6. Is this your first FDH or APHA conference?
7. Will you be receiving any funding from another institution to support your participation?

Selection notifications will go out the week of July 2, 2018 at which time you will be asked to register using our online registration form. Applications are due June 10, 2018.

Please note that all scholarship recipients are expected to volunteer up to four hours of their time at the conference and to write a brief article (100-500 words) summarizing any one of the events they attended.
